## 2. Principal's Report - Mr. Hogan

- > Classroom changes
  - A new class will be opening next week which brings a new teacher. This
    allows us to dissolve some combined classes and brings down our class
    size average.
  - This will primarily affect grades 4 and above
  - We took into consideration not to move a child two years in a row, however there may be the odd exception where we saw it was a necessary move this year
  - Impacted students will be sent home with a letter containing information of their new teacher and classroom on Friday September 21st, 2018.
     Changes take effective as of Monday September 24th, 2018.

- > International Language
  - Thank you to those delegations that spoke in July and August regarding their concerns with the delivery model of the International Languages program and the new school year schedule at St. Brigid.
  - The board has advised a survey will be sent out in November 2018 regarding the international language.

  - We can ask the board to provide formal direction / communication regarding the survey no later than October 15, 2018, thereby allowing us 1 month to conduct an information session with the parents before the survey is released
