The Victory Lap	Feb 21 – 22	Update sponsors on your results and collect remaining pledges.
Closing Ceremony	Mon, Feb 23	Return your reading log, pledge form, and cash to your classroom teacher.

- **Individual Excellence:** Prizes for top readers and top fundraisers in each division.
- **The \$25 Sprint:** Any student raising \$25 or more will receive a special incentive.
